

**VILLAGE OF RYLEY BYLAW NO.  
2024-983**

**A BYLAW FOR THE VILLAGE OF RYLEY, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, FOR THE  
PURPOSE OF PROVIDING A MUNICIPAL PUBLIC WATER UTILITY**

**WHEREAS**, Pursuant to the *Municipal Government Act*, R.S.A. 2000, Chapter M26, hereinafter called the "Act", as amended, a municipal Council has broad authority to pass bylaws respecting the municipality, including services provided by or on behalf of the municipality; and

**WHEREAS**, Pursuant to the Act, a Council may pass bylaws for municipal purposes respecting public utilities;

**WHEREAS**, Pursuant to Section 45 of the Act, the Municipality had granted a Franchise to Highway 14 Regional Water Services Commission to provide water utility services throughout the Municipality and is desirous to provide water through a Municipal Public Utility Service.

**NOW THEREFORE** under the authority of the Municipal Government Act, the Council of the Village of Ryley, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. The Village of Ryley will provide Municipal Water Public Utility Services effective February 1, 2025;
2. The Village of Ryley shall take over and manage the water distribution system within the Village of Ryley municipal boundaries;
3. Pursuant to Section 33 of the Act, the Village of Ryley hereby prohibits any person other than the municipality from providing the same or a similar type of water utility service in all or part of the municipality; and
4. That this bylaw shall take effect on the date of the third and final reading and hereby rescinds the 1992 Franchise Agreement Bylaw No. 1992-01.
