

BY-LAW NO.187.

A by-law of the Village of Ryley to require the removal of snow, ice and dirt from the sidewalks of the Village.

Under and by the virtue of the authority vested in the Council of the Village of Ryley, by Section 226 (1) of the Town and Village Act, being Chapter 150 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942, the Council enacts as follows:-

(1) All occupants of properties fronting or abutting on any of the sidewalks within the Village shall remove and clear away all snow, ice and dirt on any sidewalk fronting or abutting property occupied by them;

(2) If any person as aforesaid neglects or refuses to clear such sidewalk of all snow, ice or dirt within a period of 48 (forty-eight) hours from the occurrence on such sidewalk of said snow, ice or dirt, the council of the Village may provide for the clearing of same and any expenses incurred by the Village in so doing shall be recoverable by distress against the goods and chattels of the occupant in the same manner as if such expense were taxes levied pursuant to this Act and so recoverable.

This By-Law shall come into force immediately after the date of the passing thereof.
